GREEN RATE

AVAILABLE: To all district customers for all uses subject to established rules, policies and regulation of the District. Applicable to any Customer that agrees to purchase from the district any whole numbers of Green Energy Blocks, with such purchase in effect for (12) consecutive Billing Periods. The Green Rate is a surcharge to the billing for any of Dawson PPD's current rates.

RATE: The applicable purchase rate for each Green Energy Block shall be equal to the rate listed that is in effect at the time of the initial Billing Period for such purchase, with such rate held constant for the 12 – month term. The customer shall determine how many Green Energy Blocks they wish to purchase for a 12-month term. A charge for the Green Energy Block(s) purchased by retail customer shall be included on their monthly power bill.

The rate for Green Energy Blocks shall be \$1.80 per block per billing period. A Green Energy Block is equal to 100 kWh per month.

Customers which use less than the contracted Green Block(s) will pay the amount specified in the written Service Agreement.

MINIMUM MONTHLY CHARGE: Active Dawson Public Power District customers subject to this policy shall remain responsible for all other charges associated with the retail rate schedule.

CONDITION OF SERVICES: Service under this Green Rate policy is only applicable and available through a written Service Agreement between Dawson Public Power District and the retail customer.

TAX CLAUSE: In the event of the imposition of any new tax or increase of any existing tax or any in lieu of payment thereof, by any lawful authority, on transmission, production, or sale or electricity, the charge to be paid for each kilowatt-hour delivered and the demand charges when included in the rate, may be increased by the amount of such tax.

TERMS OF PAYMENT: The above charges are gross and due under the terms of the applicable retail rate schedule under which customer receives service.

AGREEMENT FOR PURCHASE OF GREEN ENERGY BLOCKS

Green energy blocks are made available to all Dawson Public Power District retail customers. They can be purchased in blocks of 100 kWh per month, at the current Green Energy Rate. The current Green Energy Rate is available at www.dawsonpower.com or can be mailed or emailed at the customer's request. The Green Rate is a surcharge to the billing of the customer's primary electric rate.

GREEN ENERGY RATE Q & A

What is the Green Energy Rate?

A rate offered to allow customers to purchase “green power” or renewable energy sources. When you sign up for this program, you are purchasing energy generated from Nebraska-based renewable sources. Dawson Public Power District purchases blocks of “green power” from our wholesale power provider, Nebraska Public Power District. Dawson Public Power District makes these blocks available to customers for purchase.

How do customers benefit?

The Green Energy Rate provides an opportunity to support renewable energy generation from Nebraska-based facilities. The customers will be helping to maintain the environment through their support of renewable, non-carbon emitting generation and enhancing the quality of life for Nebraskans through a cleaner environment.

How does Nebraska Public Power District benefit by the participation of Dawson Public Power District customers?

The funds assist in defraying the cost of renewable energy within the NPPD generation portfolio. Customer participation also establishes support for renewable resources.

How much should I buy?

Customers can decide how many blocks they wish to purchase each month. They may want to review their purchase history to determine how many blocks they want to purchase. If they typically use 1,000 kWh per month, they may wish to purchase 10 green power blocks of 100 kWh each month.

Where do the funds go?

Dawson Public Power purchases blocks of green power in proportion to the number of blocks sold to retail customers. The funds paid to NPPD are not earmarked for future wind or solar development. NPPD does not pre-collect revenues for future development of any generation source. Rather the Green Energy Rate promotes customer support of existing wind generation.

Is the money I spend on the Green Rate tax deductible?

No. It is not a charitable contribution and therefore is not tax deductible.

What if I sign up and change my mind?

You can cancel your Green Rate participation at the end of your current billing cycle. Contact Dawson Public Power District if you would like to end your contract.

Does the renewable energy I purchase come directly to my house?

Due to the way electricity is transmitted and distributed, energy purchased or produced from renewable

energy resources mix with other generation sources on the electric grid and may not be specifically delivered to you. However, the renewable energy you purchase will be added to the power grid and will displace incremental power that would have otherwise been produced from traditional generating resources.
