# Heat Pump Water Heater Incentive Program

(Effective January 1, 2016)

<b>Heat Pump Water Heater - Incentives</b>		
<b>System Type</b>	<b>Incentive Criteria</b>	<b>Incentive Amount</b>
Air Source Heat Pump Water Heater	EF > 1.9	\$200
Water or Ground Source Heat Pump Water Heater	EF > 2.8	\$500

In addition, a low interest loan for the heat pump water heater system is also available, through the Nebraska Energy Office's "**Dollar and Energy Savings Loan Program**" for your new qualifying system.

# Heat Pump Water Heater Program Guidelines

The following guidelines will generally apply. Exceptions will be handled on a case-by-case basis.

1. All heat pump water heaters must be permanently installed.
2. An incentive payment will be paid to the owner after the equipment is installed, operating, and tested by the installer to manufacturer recommendations. No incentive(s) will be paid without the completion of the application form. The application form must then be signed by both the installer and the owner. This form will then be submitted to the owner's electric utility.
3. The incentive payment to the owner will come directly from their local electric utility.
4. Low Interest Loan - For homeowners who choose this option the program is administered through the Nebraska Energy Offices – Dollar and Energy Savings Loan Program. For more information go to [www.neo.ne.gov](http://www.neo.ne.gov) (Dollar and Energy Savings Loan)
5. Program is subject to the Terms and Conditions as outlined on the application and to the General Guidelines.
