**RATE STABILIZATION.** Carmen reviewed rate stabilization funds, including the purpose, use, and current amounts designated for rate stabilization. Carmen then discussed the 2023 numbers in light of the District's financial boundaries. Based on the financial considerations, Carmen's recommendation for this year is to not add additional funds to rate stabilization. The board discussed options, including revisiting a rate stabilization designation later in the year.

Motion by Director Wietjes to not add additional funds to rate stabilization at this time. Seconded by Director Jeffrey. Motion carried unanimously.

**INTERLOCAL DRAFT AND DISCUSSION.** Dave Jarecke joined the board for a discussion of a draft interlocal agreement with CNPPID.
